

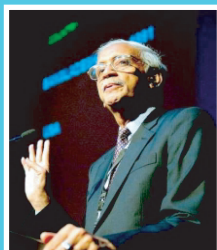

services in the field of Disaster Risk Management (DRM) at home and abroad.

Graduated from the Australian Counter Disaster College in Disasters Services Administration, Saidur held important positions such as the Country Representative for Oxfam-UK in Bangladesh, Deputy Country Representative for Oxfam-UK in Somalia, Deputy Secretary General of Bangladesh Red Cross Society and the First Director of the widely acclaimed Cyclone Preparedness Programme (CPP).

Mr. Farid Hasan Ahmed has been engaged in programme design and management at the senior level in humanitarian, post humanitarian and normal situations. He has been managing DRR capacity building programme with different actors in

Bangladesh. He is active in advocacy and lobbying with different actors. He had practical experiences on DRR and related issues both in country and abroad while he worked with Oxfam GB, Concern World Wide and Dhv consultants. He is now working with Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation SDC as a Senior Programme Officer. He is a lawyer.
